

HOW TO DISABLE DIRECTORY LISTING

For Apache 2:

1. The configuration file is probably here:
`/etc/httpd/conf/httpd.conf`
OR
If you are using apache from the source tar balls probably you will find the configuration file here:
`/usr/local/apache/conf/httpd.conf`
2. Using an editor like vi, notepad, etc edit the httpd.conf file and scroll until you find a line like this:
Options All Indexes FollowSymLinks
(Located between <Directory "/var/www/html"> and </Directory>)
3. To disable directory browsing carefully change the line that says: **Indexes** as below:
Options All FollowSymLinks -Indexes
4. Restart your apache webserver
(The configuration above was tested using **Apache 2** on **Linux CentOS 5**)

For IIS 5 & IIS 6:

1. Go to Control Panel -> Administrative Tools -> Internet Information Services
2. Double click on the local computer name
3. Double click 'websites' (folder)
4. Right click on 'Default Web Site' -> Choose Properties
5. Click 'Home Directory' tab
6. Check or uncheck 'Directory Browsing' box to enable or disable directory browsing
