## Disabling WebDAV on IIS 5

### Solution:

Completely disable WebDAV including the PUT and DELETE requests, make the following changes in the registry:

1. Start Registry Editor (Regedt32.exe).
2. Locate and click the following key in the registry:  
**HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SYSTEM\CurrentControlSet\Services\W3SVC\Parameters**
3. On the **Edit** menu, click **Add Value**, and then add the following registry value:

Value name: DisableWebDAV

Data type: DWORD

Value data: 1

4. Restart IIS. This change does not take effect until the IIS service or the server is restarted.

**Note** Because the Internet Database Connector (IDC) script mappings support the **OPTIONS** verb, you may notice HTTP 200 OK notifications in the IIS 5.0 Web logs after you add the DisableWebDav subkey.
